Explanation of increases in the budget:
The increase in General Service is to maintain the General Basic maximum levy rate of \$3.50 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation, to increase the health rates back to normal from the decrease in 2020-2023. support of Marshall County Communications Commission through the county-wide levy, and to maintain necessary fund balances.

The above tax rates do not include county voted levies, mental health and disabilities services levy, debt service levy and the rates of other local jurisdictions.
