MARSHALL COUNTY DRIVEWAY POLICY

Marshall County does not install new driveways. The person requesting a driveway permit is responsible for all costs of the installation. The applicant is also responsible for the costs to widen a driveway. Driveways not installed according to specification are subject to removal by the county at the owner's expense. See Section 319.14 Code of Iowa.

Legal Driveways in existence prior to January 1, 1976: Marshall County will widen, at no cost to the applicant, a driveway not currently 20 ft. wide. If the applicant requests a drive wider than 20 ft., the county will furnish the pipe needed to make the drive 20 ft. wide; any other costs to widen beyond 20 ft. will be the responsibility of the applicant.

MARSHALL COUNTY DRIVEWAY SPECIFICATIONS

Marshall County will determine if a culvert is required and the minimum size and length of the culvert for the desired drive width. The **minimum** acceptable diameter of any driveway needing a culvert shall be 15 inches.

Only **new** culvert pipe shall be installed. The pipe shall be corrugated metal pipe meeting Iowa DOT specifications. The county must inspect any pipe not purchased from the county before installation of the drive.

Driveway side slopes on granular surfaced roads shall be no steeper than a 2:1 slope. Drives on a paved road with a speed limit of 40 mph or greater shall have side slopes of 10:1 on dry fills and 8:1/6:1 when a culvert is required. End sections will be required for all drives on paved roads. See the back side of this form.

Farm entrance drives are to be surfaced with crushed stone or other approved material. **Field entrance drives** need not be surfaced.

Once the drive is installed according to specifications and approved by Marshall County, **any future costs of maintaining the driveway culvert** will be paid by Marshall County. For this reason, all culverts installed must be new corrugated metal pipe (CMP) meeting the Iowa DOT specifications

Marshall County assumes no liability for the crossing's installation.
