~~Vice President~~ Pam Paone called the regular meeting of the Marshall County Conservation Board to order on Monday, February 12, held at GrimesFarm and Conservation Center, at 5:04 p.m.

Board members present were Tom Mack, Jeff Mathis, Pam Paone, Steve Armstrong and Ray Helland. Staff present was Mike Stegmann, Tami Krough, and Tyler Renze. Public present was Bill Patten, Corey Damman, Mike Fitz, Sue Blaisdell, Connie Allen, and Scott Allen.

There being no correction or additions to the minutes of January 8, they were declared approved as presented.

On a motion by Mack, seconded by Helland, the Board approved the list of claims as presented with addendums. Voting in favor: Helland, Mack, Paone, Armstrong, and Mathis. Motion carried.

Sealed bids for 89.27 acres of cropland at Klauenberg, 19.21 acres will managed as part of the ISU STRIPS program. Bidders present had the option to raise their bid if they desired after bid opening.

Bidders were:

- Mike Fitz - \$175/acre
- Scott Allen - \$175/acre

Corey Damman from C&C Farms chose to raise their big to \$180/acre. Scott Allen raised the bid to \$185/acre. Damman raised his bid to \$190/acre.

Mack moved to accept the bid of C&C Farms for \$190/acre. Seconded by Paone. Voting in favor: Mathis, Paone, Mack, Armstrong, and Helland. Motion carried.

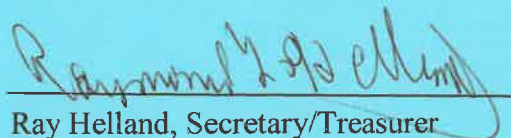
Stegmann discussed the possibility of a 33 acre land donation from Bill Ernst and what could be done with the land.
