

Marshall County Conservation Board
Regular Meeting June 10, 2019
Grimes Farm and Conservation Center.....5:00 p.m.

President Tom Mack called the regular meeting of the Marshall County Conservation Board to order on Monday, June 10, held at Grimes Farm and Conservation Center, at 5:00 p.m.

Board members present were Pam Paone, Jeff Mathis, Steve Armstrong, Ray Helland, and Tom Mack. Staff present was Mike Stegmann, Tyler Renze, and Tami Krough. Public present was Sue Blaisdell.

No public comment

There being no correction or additions to the minutes of May 13, they were declared approved as presented.

On a motion by Mathis, seconded by Paone, the Board approved the list of claims as presented with addendums. Voting in favor: Paone, Mathis, Armstrong, Helland, and Mack. Motion carried.

Stegmann asked for approval to expense interpretive sign design for the observation tower by WildKey Creative. The board moved to table this item for clarification on the contract.

Stegmann presented a quote from Wood Graphics to make new park signs for Green Castle Recreation Area and Grimes Farm. The cost of the sign for Grimes Farm is \$5,280 and the cost of the sign for Green Castle Recreation Area is \$3,780. Armstrong moved to have Wood Graphics make the new park signs. Helland seconded. Voting in favor: Paone, Mathis, Armstrong, Helland, and Mack. Motion carried.

Stegmann requested approval for Fiscal Year 20 salary increases for employees. Armstrong moved to approve the salary increases for employees for FY20. Paone seconded. Voting in favor: Paone, Mathis, Armstrong, Helland, and Mack. Motion carried.

The date was set for the end of year of claims meeting at Tuesday, June 18 at Noon.

Non action items discussed: Meeting with United States Fish and Wildlife Service regarding the pollinator areas at the Iowa River Wildlife Management Area, meeting with NRCS regarding the Mann property, repairs to the log cabin, changes to the amphitheater, and Green Castle fishing.
