There being no correction or additions to the minutes of November 12, they were declared approved as presented.

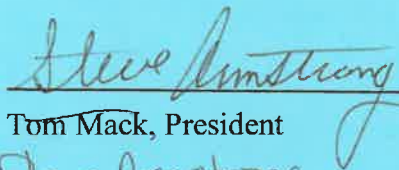
