President Tom Mack called the regular meeting of the Marshall County Conservation Board to order on Monday, February 10, held at GrimesFarm and Conservation Center, at 5:01 p.m.

Board members present were Steve Armstrong, Jeff Mathis, Pam Paone, and Ray Helland. Staff present was Mike Stegmann, Jeremiah Mankin, and Tami Krough. Board member Ray Helland was absent.

There being no correction or additions to the minutes of January 13, they were declared approved as presented.
