

Marshall County Conservation Board  
Regular Meeting June 8, 2020

President, Steve Armstrong called the regular meeting of the Marshall County Conservation Board to order on Monday, June 8 at GrimesFarm and Conservation Center at 5:02 p.m.

Board members present were Steve Armstrong, Pam Paone, and Tom Mack. Staff present was Mike Stegmann and Tami Krough.

There were no changes to the agenda.

There being no correction or additions to the minutes of May 11, they were declared approved as presented

On a motion by Paone, seconded by Mack, the Board approved the list of claims as presented with addendums. Voting in favor: Armstrong, Mack, and Paone. Motion carried.

Stegmann asked for approval to purchase a new kiosk for Grimes Farm. Cost for the new kiosk is \$2,183.12. Mack moved to purchase the new kiosk for \$2,183.12. Paone seconded. Voting in favor: Armstrong, Mack, and Paone. Motion carried.

Stegmann requested approval for a new park identification signage for the Iowa River Wildlife Management Area and the Bill Ernst Outdoor Training Complex. Mack moved to purchase the park identification signage for \$2,364.92. Paone seconded. Voting in favor: Armstrong, Mack, and Paone. Motion carried.

Stegmann presented information to the board regarding constructing a new 20'x20' shelter at Sand Lake Recreation Area. This shelter would be made from steel. Mack moved to approve the construction of a new shelter at Sand Lake Recreation Area. Paone seconded. Voting in favor: Armstrong, Mack, and Paone. Motion carried.

Stegmann provided the board with the 2021 ICCS strategic transition survey.

Non-action items: David Roe memorial fund for purchasing perch for Green Castle Recreation Area, and the Extern and Assistant Naturalist starting.
