

Marshall County Conservation Board
Regular Meeting August 14, 2020
GrimesFarm and Conservation Center.....4:00 p.m.

Secretary, Pam Paone called the regular meeting of the Marshall County Conservation Board to order on Friday, August 14 at GrimesFarm and Conservation Center at 4:01 p.m.

Board members present were Pam Paone, Rich Naughton, Tom Deimerly, and Tom Mack. Staff present was Mike Stegmann, and Tami Krough. Public present was Sam Douds. There were no changes to the agenda.

There were not corrections to the minutes of July 13, they were declared approved as presented.

On a motion by Deimerly, seconded by Mack, the Board approved the list of claims as presented with addendums. Voting in favor: Mack, Deimerly, Naughton, and Paone. Motion carried.

Stegmann asked the board for permission to allow archery deer hunting only in MCCB refuge areas (Timmons South, Grimes Farm north of Linn Creek, Coppock Park, Grammer Grove, Wickersham West, French Grove, and Stewart Bird Sanctuary per City hunt regulations). Sam Douds, that owns property next to Wickersham West, voiced concerns about trespassers on his property. Mack moved to approve archery deer hunting only in the refuge areas. Naughton seconded the motion. Voting in favor: Mack, Deimerly, Naughton, and Paone. Motion carried.

Stegmann requested approval to make the expense to \$2,703 with Bjelland and Web Electric to install a washer and dryer in the cleaning supply closet at the Nature Center. Mack moved to approve the expense for the installation of a washer and dryer in the Nature Center. Deimerly seconded. Voting in favor: Mack, Deimerly, Naughton, and Paone. Motion carried.

Stegmann recommended the hiring of Alan Naughton for the open Maintenance Technician position. Deimerly moved to approve the hiring of Alan Naughton for the Maintenance Technician position. Mack seconded. Voting in favor: Mack, Deimerly, and Paone. Naughton sustained from the vote due to conflict of interest. Motion carried.

Stegmann discussed the damage to the parks from the derecho.

Meeting adjourned at 4:47 p.m.
