There was one change to the agenda, removal of item E.

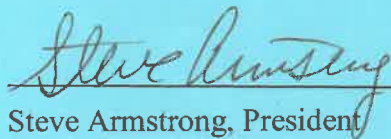
There was no corrections to the minutes of October 12, they were declared approved as presented.
