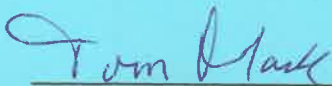

Herring sought approval for the design, purchase, and installation of trail signs at Grammer Grove. Total cost of the project is \$6,250.00. Naughton moved to approve the design, purchase, and installation of trail signs at Grammer Grove. Armstrong seconded the motion. Voting in favor: Mack, Paone, Deimerly, Armstrong, and Naughton. Motion carried.

Herring asked the board to approve the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) Fish Habit Agreement for armoring the shoreline of the Sand Lake addition at cost of \$46,570.00. Deimerly moved to approve the Fish Habitat Agreement with IDNR for armoring the shoreline of the Sand Lake addition. Naughton seconded the motion. Voting in favor: Mack, Paone, Deimerly, Armstrong, and Naughton. Motion carried.
