MARSHALL COUNTY COMMISSION OF VETERANS AFFAIRS MEETING Regular Meeting – July 1, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 pm by Commissioner Grimes. Also in attendance were Commissioners David Streets, Bob Grimes, Executive Director Kevin Huseboe, County Veterans Service Officer Shari Coughenour, Ex-officio member Board of Supervisor Jarret Heil. Absent: Commissioner Kessler.

Roll Call: Present: Streets, Grimes, Heil. Huseboe led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Streets moved to approve regular minutes dated May 6, 2025, second by Grimes. There were no minutes in June, due to lack of quorum. Motion carried 2-0.

Streets moved to approve the claims as presented, second by Grimes. Motion carried 2-0.

The Commission reviewed the following reports

- a. Budget / expenses through FYE June 30, 2025
- b. Number of Veterans helped, by county and what type of reports were filed to the Veterans Affairs on behalf of the Veterans.
- c. New report from the State IDVA, lists by county number of veterans/survivors receiving VA monies. In the month of May, 883 Marshall County Veterans/Survivors received \$1,494,852.
Total monies from January 2025 – May 2025: \$7,343,697.00

State IDVA has issued requirements for all State of Iowa VSOs to increase CEU's from 16 to 20 annually. The National requirement is 16.

The Commission and Director discussed closing the office for vacation July 14 – July 18. Appointments will be rescheduled during that time. Shari will monitor calls and keep the van going.
