MARSHALL COUNTY COMMISSION OF VETERANS AFFAIRS MEETING Regular Meeting – August 5, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 2:11 pm by Chairman Streets. Also in attendance were Commissioners David Streets, Bob Grimes, Executive Director Kevin Huseboe, County Veterans Service Officer Shari Coughenour. Absent: Ex-officio member Board of Supervisor Jarret Heil and: Commissioner Kessler.

Roll Call: Present: Streets, Grimes. Streets and Grimes fully participated via speakerphone.

Grimes moved to approve regular minutes dated July 1, 2025, second by Streets. Motion carried 2-0.

Streets moved to approve the claims as presented, second by Grimes. Motion carried 2-0.

The Commission reviewed the following reports

- a. Budget / expenses through July 31, 2025
- b. Number of Veterans helped, by county and what type of reports were filed to the Veterans Affairs on behalf of the Veterans.
- c. New report from the State IDVA, lists by county number of veterans/survivors receiving VA monies. In the month of June, 885 Marshall County Veterans/Survivors received \$1,525,062.
Total monies from January 2025 – June 2025: \$8,868,759.00

There have been two presumptively eligible inquiries about the Home Base Iowa relocation program, waiting to hear from the Board of Supervisors if there are monies are available through June 30, 2026, for the \$2,000 per approved relocation applicant.

Streets moved to approve sending the Tyler Technologies Memorandum of Understanding, Tyler End User License Agreement, November 3, 2025 – November 2, 2026, to the Board of Supervisors for their consideration / approval at their next meeting, second by Grimes. Motion carried 2-0
