MARSHALL COUNTY COMMISSION OF VETERANS AFFAIRS MEETING Regular Meeting – September 2, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 2:11 pm by Chairman Streets. Also in attendance were Commissioners David Streets, Bob Grimes, Executive Director Kevin Huseboe, County Veterans Service Officer Shari Coughenour, Ex-officio member Board of Supervisor Jarret Heil. Absent: Commissioner Kessler.

Roll Call: Present: Streets, Grimes.

Streets moved to approve regular minutes dated August 5, 2025, second by Grimes. Motion carried 2-0.

Streets moved to approve the claims as presented, second by Grimes. Motion carried 2-0.

The Commission reviewed the following reports

- a. Budget / expenses through August 31, 2025
- b. Number of Veterans helped, by county and what type of reports were filed to the Veterans Affairs on behalf of the Veterans.
- c. New report from the State IDVA, lists by county number of veterans/survivors receiving VA monies. In the month of June, 885 Marshall County Veterans/Survivors received \$1,525,062.
Total monies from January 2025 – July 2025: \$10,421,296

There have been two presumptively eligible inquiries about the Home Base Iowa relocation program, waiting to hear from the Board of Supervisors if there are monies are available through June 30, 2026, for the \$2,000 per approved relocation applicant. Supervisor Heil advised he would check if there were available funds in the Economic Development line for this purpose.

3. Banner sales should begin November 1, 2025, by MCBF. Director Lakin is working on a new banner design.
