

Marshall County Conservation Board
Regular Meeting September 8, 2025
GrimesFarm and Conservation Center.....4:00 p.m.

President, Tom Mack called the regular meeting of the Marshall County Conservation to order on Monday, September 8, 2025, at the GrimesFarm and Conservation Center at 4:00 p.m. Board members present were: Rich Naughton, Tom Deimerly, Pam Paone, and Tom Mack. Staff present were Tami Krough and Emily Herring. Public present was Lucas Wilson from Clapsaddle-Garber Associates (CGA). Board member Steve Armstrong was absent.

There are no changes to the agenda.

No public comment.

There were no corrections to the minutes of August 11, 2025, they were declared approved as presented.

On a motion by Deimerly, seconded by Paone the Board approved the list of claims as presented with addendums. Voting in favor: Mack, Paone, Deimerly, and Naughton. Motion carried.

Herring asked the board to approve the Archeological Study for Three Bridges County Park. Two proposals received were:

- Bear Creek \$35,245.00
- Eocene \$46,352.00

Deimerly moved to approve the Archeological Study by Bear Creek. Naughton seconded. Voting in favor: Mack, Paone, Deimerly, and Naughton. Motion carried.

Herring requested approval for concrete work to be completed at Green Castle Recreation Area near Gander Lookout Shelter by JV Concepts at a cost of \$4,000.00. Deimerly moved to approve the concrete work at Green Castle Recreation Area. Paone seconded. Voting in favor: Mack, Paone, Deimerly, and Naughton. Motion carried.

Herring sought approval to purchase trees for planting Phase II of the Green Castle Recreation Area Campground Project and to replace trees at both Timmons Grove and Sand Lake. Total cost of the trees would be \$5,500.00. Deimerly moved to approve the purchase of the trees. Naughton seconded. Voting in favor: Mack, Paone, Deimerly, and Naughton. Motion carried.

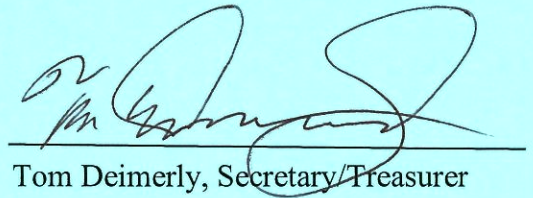
Herring requested the board approve Pay Estimate No 3 to Steele Excavating for Phase II of the Green Castle Recreation Area Campground Project. Lucas Wilson (CGA) provided updates on the project. Deimerly moved to approve Pay Estimate No 3 to Steele Excavating of \$19,912.00. Paone seconded. Voting in favor: Mack, Paone, Deimerly, and Naughton. Motion carried.

The board discussed allowing archery deer hunting only in MCCB wildlife management areas (Timmons South, Grimes Farm north of Linn Creek, Coppock Park, Grammer Grove, Wickersham West, Stewart Bird Sanctuary, and French Grove). Deimerly made a motion to allow ARCHERY ONLY deer hunting in the following normally designated Marshall County managed wildlife management areas: Coppock Park, Timmons South, Grimes Farm north of Linn Creek, Wickersham West, Stewart Bird Sanctuary, French Grove, and Grammer Grove. Naughton seconded. Voting in favor: Paone, Naughton, Mack, and Deimerly. Motion carried.

Non-action items discussed: Albion dump station

Naughon moved to adjourn the meeting. Paone seconded. The meeting adjourned at 5:29 p.m.
