A review of the Strategic Plan was held.

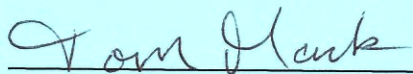

Voting in favor: Paone, Mack, Naughton, Deimerly, and Armstrong. Motion carried.

Herring asked the board to approve the purchase of 4 bison (2 females with 2 calves) for \$9,000.00. Naughton moved to approve the purchase of the 4 bison. Deimerly seconded. Voting in favor: Paone, Mack, Naughton, Deimerly, and Armstrong. Motion carried.

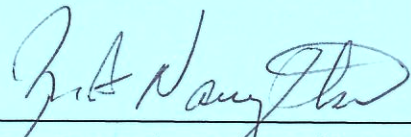
Non action items: new board member, Three Bridges
