There were no corrections to the minutes of January 17, 2026, they were declared approved as presented.

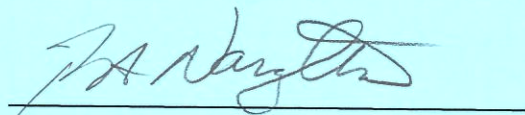

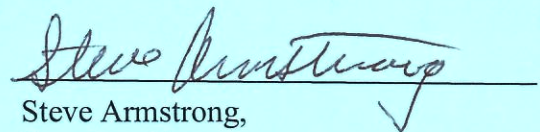
