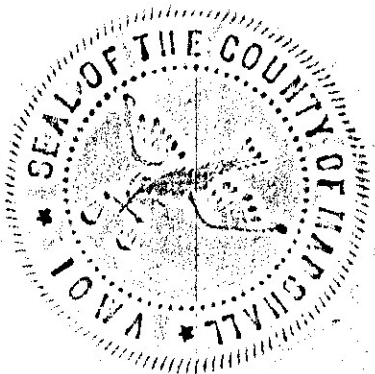

The effective date for the City of Liscomb ended on December 31, 2001; and
On February 18, 2003, the City of Liscomb held a Special Election on the following Public Measure A:

To authorize imposition of a Local Sales and Services Tax in City of Liscomb, County of Marshall at the rate of one percent (1%) to take effect on July 1, 2003. Revenues from the sales and services tax are to be allocated in the City of Liscomb, County of Marshall, as follows:

1. Zero percent (0%) for property tax relief.
2. The specific purpose for which the revenues will otherwise be expended is: any lawful purpose of the City of Liscomb; and

At the Canvass of the Liscomb Special Election it was determined that said Public Measure A passed.

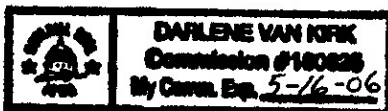
