

**Marshall County
Ordinance #27**

Quarantine and Isolation

The Board of Supervisors adopts, by reference, Iowa Administrative Code 641, Chapter 1 (referenced below), "Quarantine and Isolation" and the following statement regarding temporary, and quarantine without notice. "The Board of Health, in its discretion, may authorize an individual Board member, or the Supervisor of Public Health, to issue the oral order in the Board's absence. If a temporary isolation or quarantine of an individual or groups of individuals occurs through an oral order, the Board shall issue a written order as soon as is reasonably possible and in all cases within 24 hours of issuance of the oral order if continued isolation or quarantine is necessary to prevent or limit the transmission of a communicable or possibly communicable disease."

Be It Further Resolved that this Ordinance shall become effective after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
