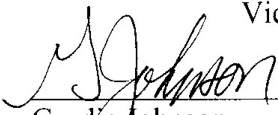
Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Marshall County Board of Supervisors that this be considered the first reading, by reference, of the proposed Marshall County Ordinance #27, which is Iowa Administrative Code 641, Chapter 1, "Quarantine and Isolation", and the following statement regarding temporary, and quarantine without notice. "The Board of Health, in its discretion, may authorize an individual Board member, or the Supervisor of Public Health, to issue the oral order in the Board's absence. If a temporary isolation or quarantine of an individual or groups of individuals occurs through an oral order, the Board shall issue a written order as soon as is reasonably possible and in all cases within 24 hours of issuance of the oral order if continued isolation or quarantine is necessary to prevent or limit the transmission of a communicable or possibly communicable disease."
